
Puerto Rico ranked 38th in Regular Army (RA) soldier transitions. 1% (303) of the RA population for FY23 transitioned to Puerto Rico.


PR FY23 RA Transitions

Top 10 Transition From Installations








Demographics of the 303 RA Soldiers that transitioned to Puerto Rico in FY23.








Demographics of RA Soldiers that transitioned to Puerto Rico in FY23.


Top 10 MOSs
